## Month's Mind High Mass of Requiem

The tradition of the Month's Mind Mass commemorated the deceased about 30, 60 and 90 days after death. The traditions associated with this Mass go back to medieval England. The Mass was the standard Requiem Mass with several prayers added specifically for those who had passed away during the previous months.

The Requiem Mass, also known as Mass for the dead (*Latin: Missa pro defunctis*) or Mass of the dead (*Latin: Missa defunctorum*), is a Mass of the Catholic Church offered for the repose of the soul or souls of one or more deceased persons, using a particular form of the Roman Missal.

Our Month's Mind Requiem Mass will be celebrated in Latin according to the Roman Missal of 1962 with the Final Absolution at the Catafalque at the conclusion of the Mass.
