And that has never changed.*

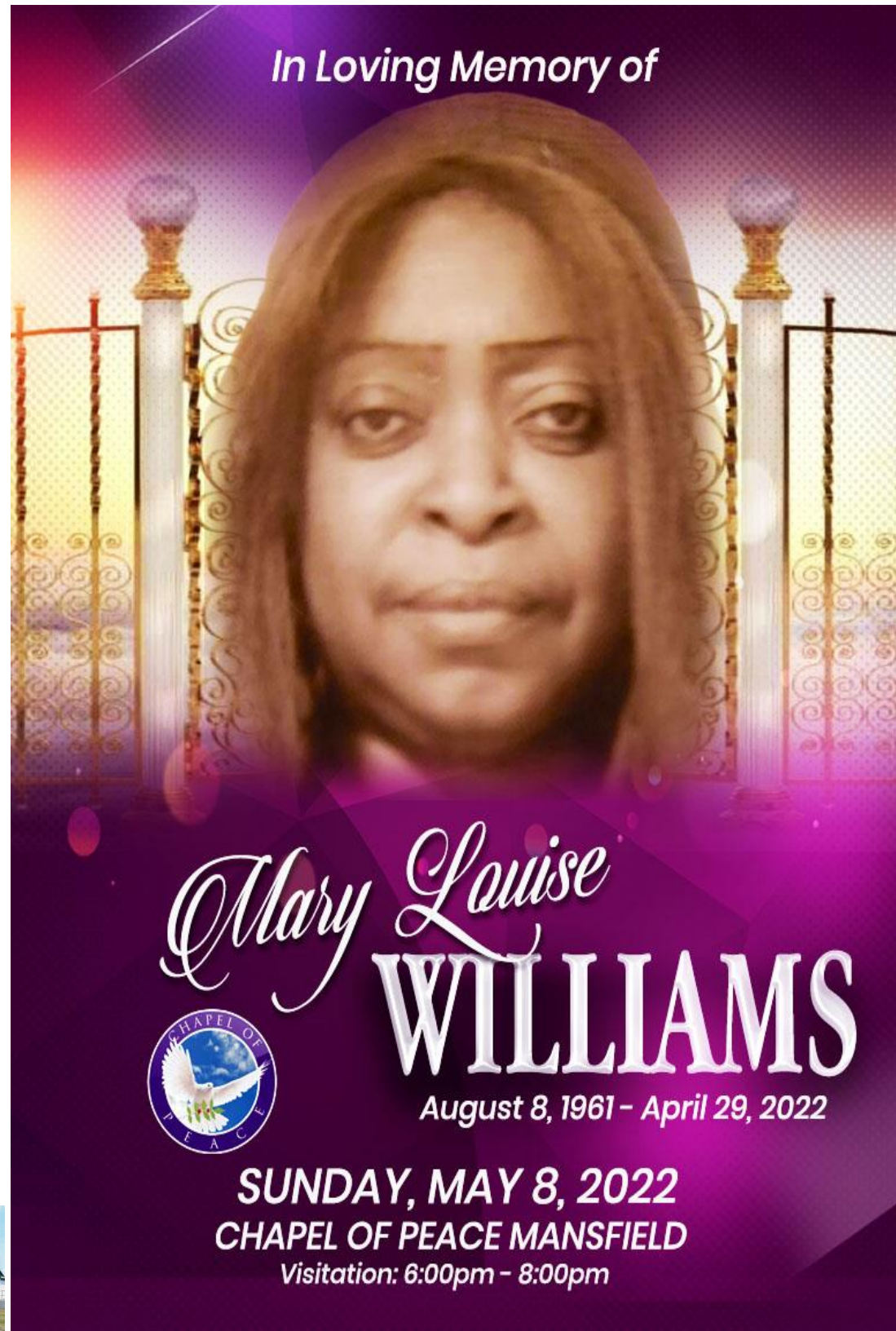
