Only life as it should be; My love, My life.*

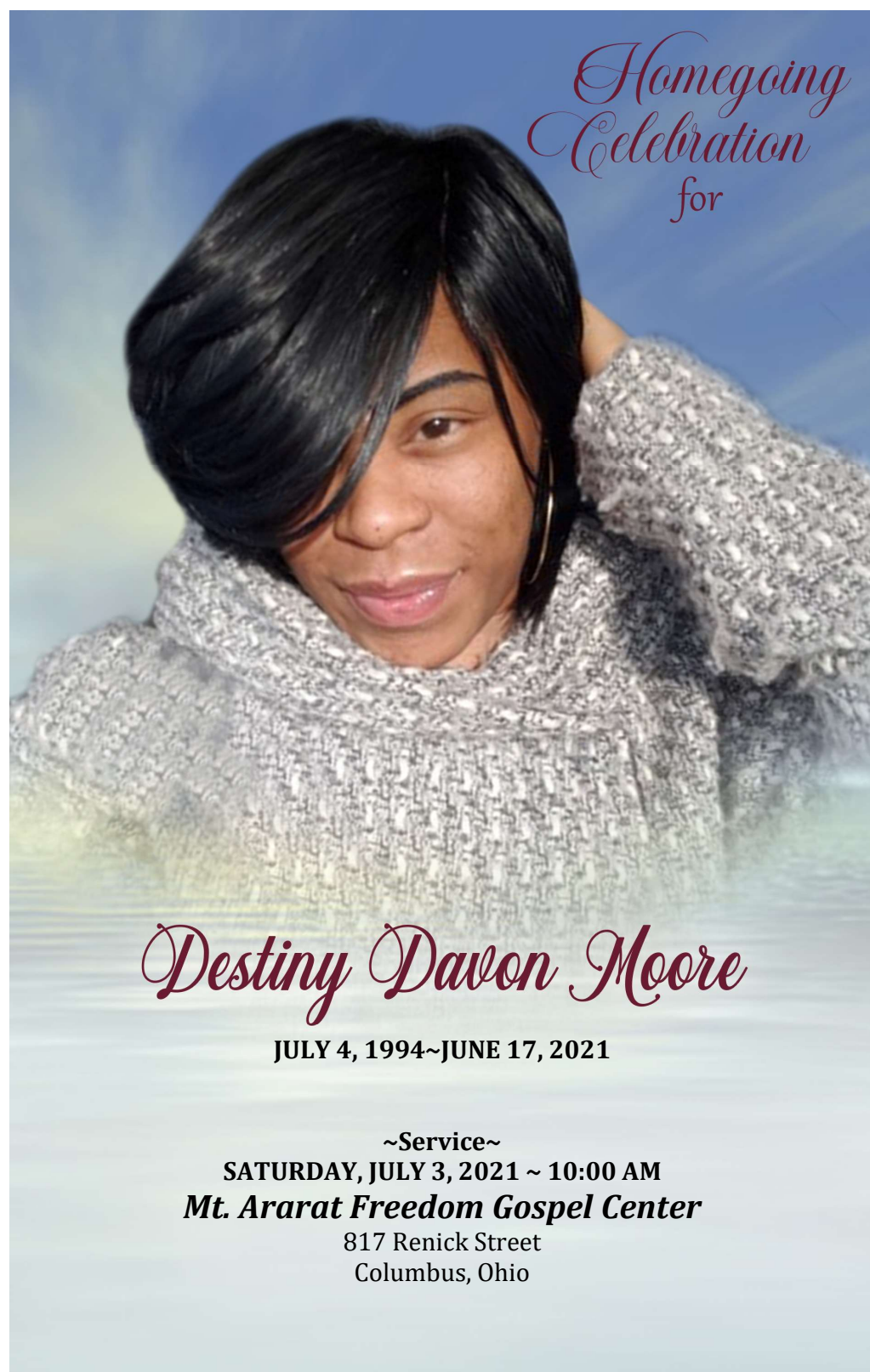
