

Obituary

Arthur Lee Fluellen passed away peacefully in his sleep, August 8, 2022, in the comfort of home. He was 74 years old living with his daughter, son-in-law and grandchildren in Hilliard, Ohio.

Arthur was born on November 13, 1947 to mother Jesse Washington in Hurtsburo, Alabama. At the age of four he, his mother and older brother Will moved to East Chicago, Illinois to grow up and live amongst family and extended relatives in the city.

During his youth in East Chicago, Arthur excelled academically and athletically from elementary school through secondary school at East Chicago Washington High School. As a youth he participated in football, basketball, track and baseball - of which he was selected as an All-City Little League baseball and track team member.

Arthur continued his high school career taking honors classes and attaining a spot on the esteemed East Chicago Washington Senators varsity basketball team - which was once featured in Sports Illustrated as "the best dressed team" in high school basketball. His academic strength and participation on the basketball team ultimately lead Arthur to a basketball scholarship at Aquinas College in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

Upon completion of college, Arthur joined the United States Air Force and was stationed in Columbia, South Carolina. He returned to Michigan in 1973 to be with his son and live the majority of his remaining adult life.

Arthur went on to build a full and rich life in Battle Creek, Michigan with the love of his life, wife and school teacher Mattie Fluellen and two children, Bryce and Jessica. He worked as a financial services professional before starting his career with the Federal Center in Battle Creek, Michigan. Arthur had 25 years of service as an Analyst before retiring in 2005.

Arthur enjoyed spending time with his family, chatting with friends, playing golf and watching sports. He was also an avid reader and great lover of jazz music. But most of all, he dedicated his life to raising and loving his two children and spoiling his beautiful grandchildren - the true loves of his incredible life.
