Why, when I needed you most, have you not been there for me?"

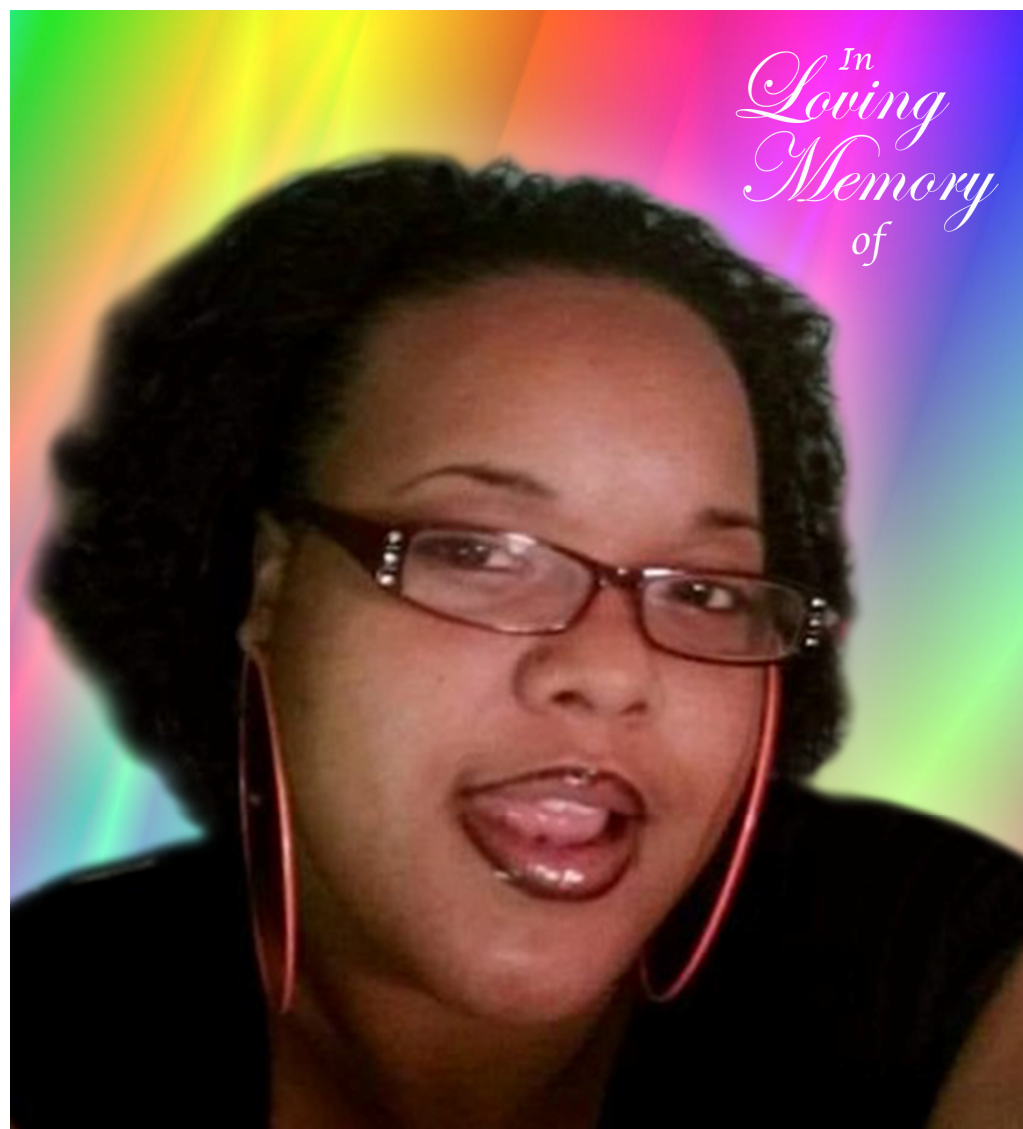
The Lord replied, "The times when you have seen
