The day God called you home*

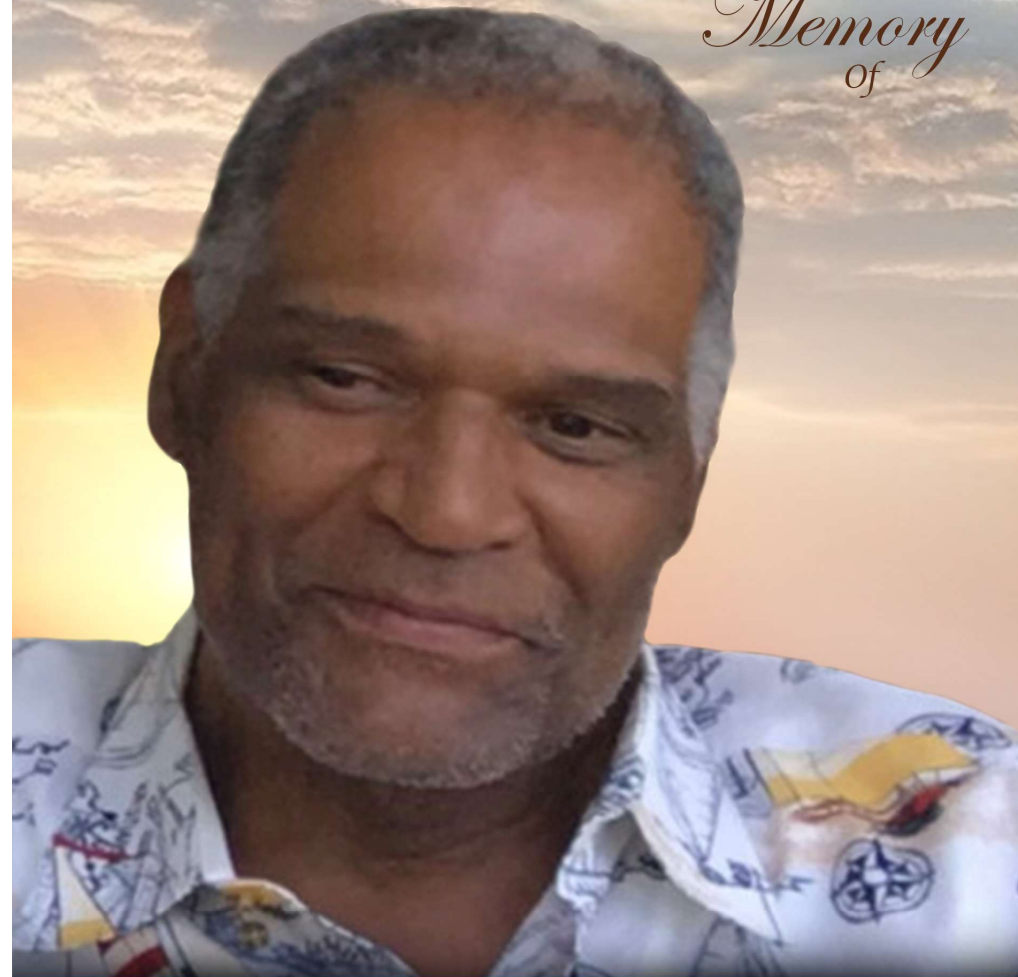
