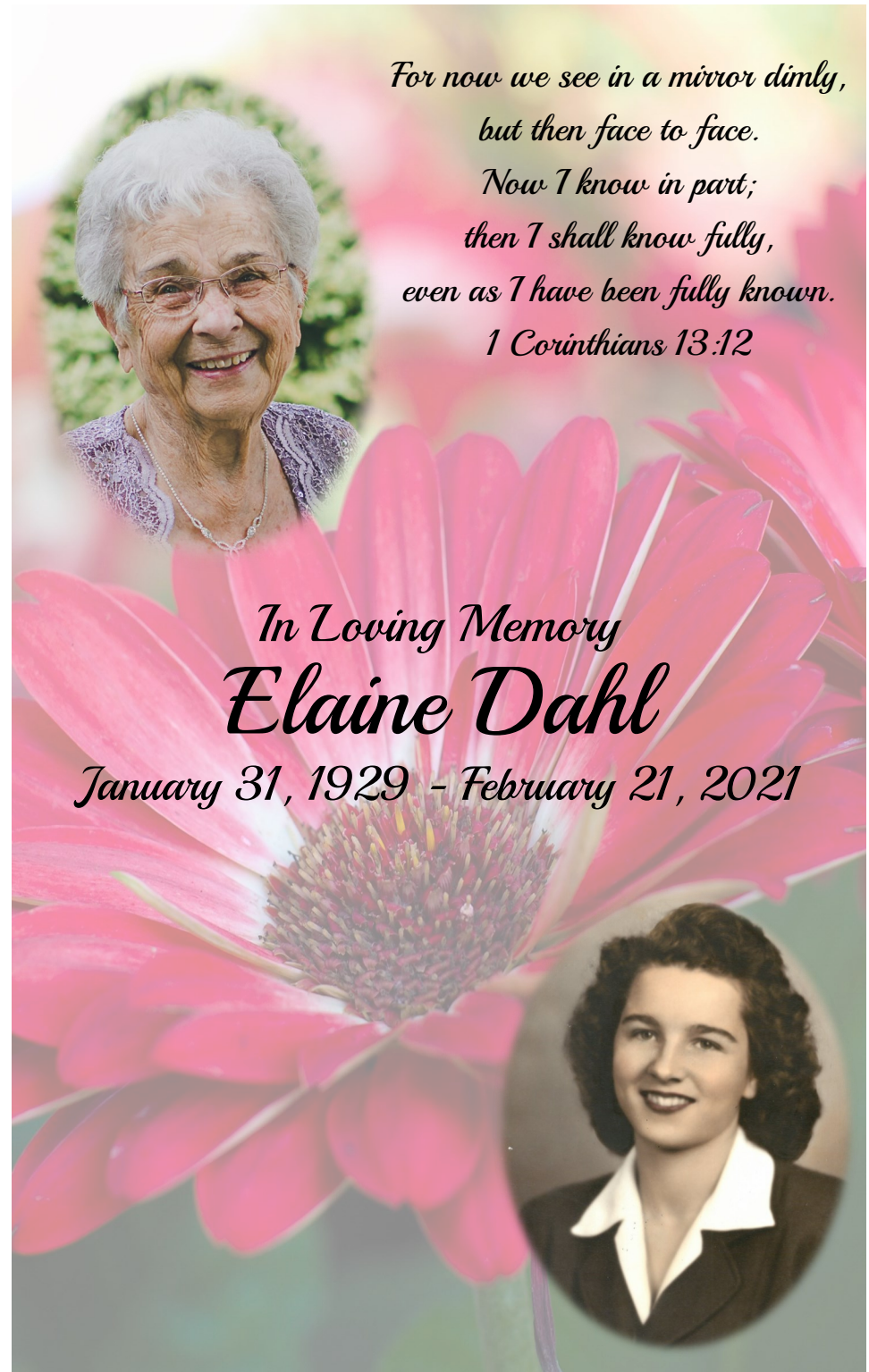


Mothers Never Die
