until the very end.

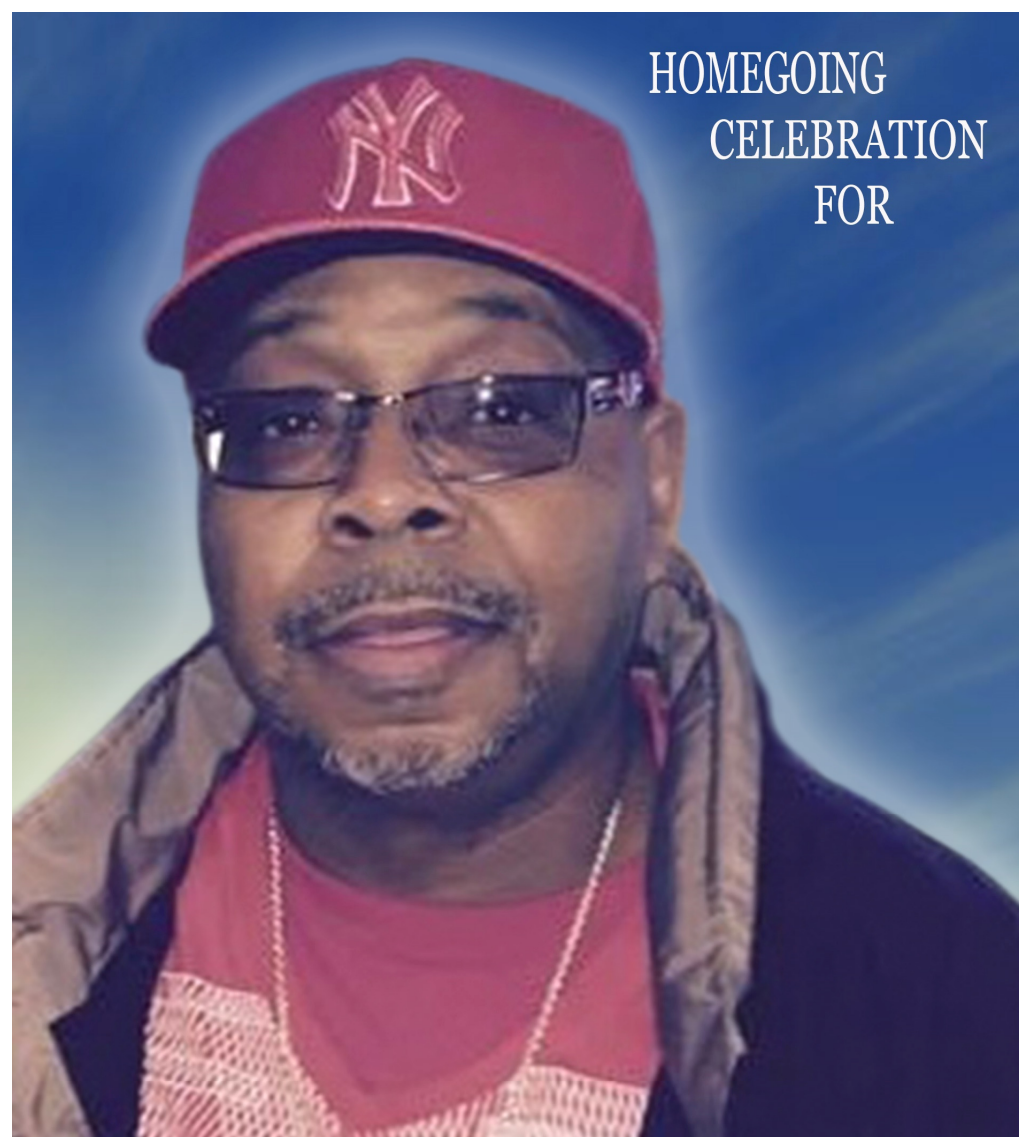
