Then turned and bid farewell to all

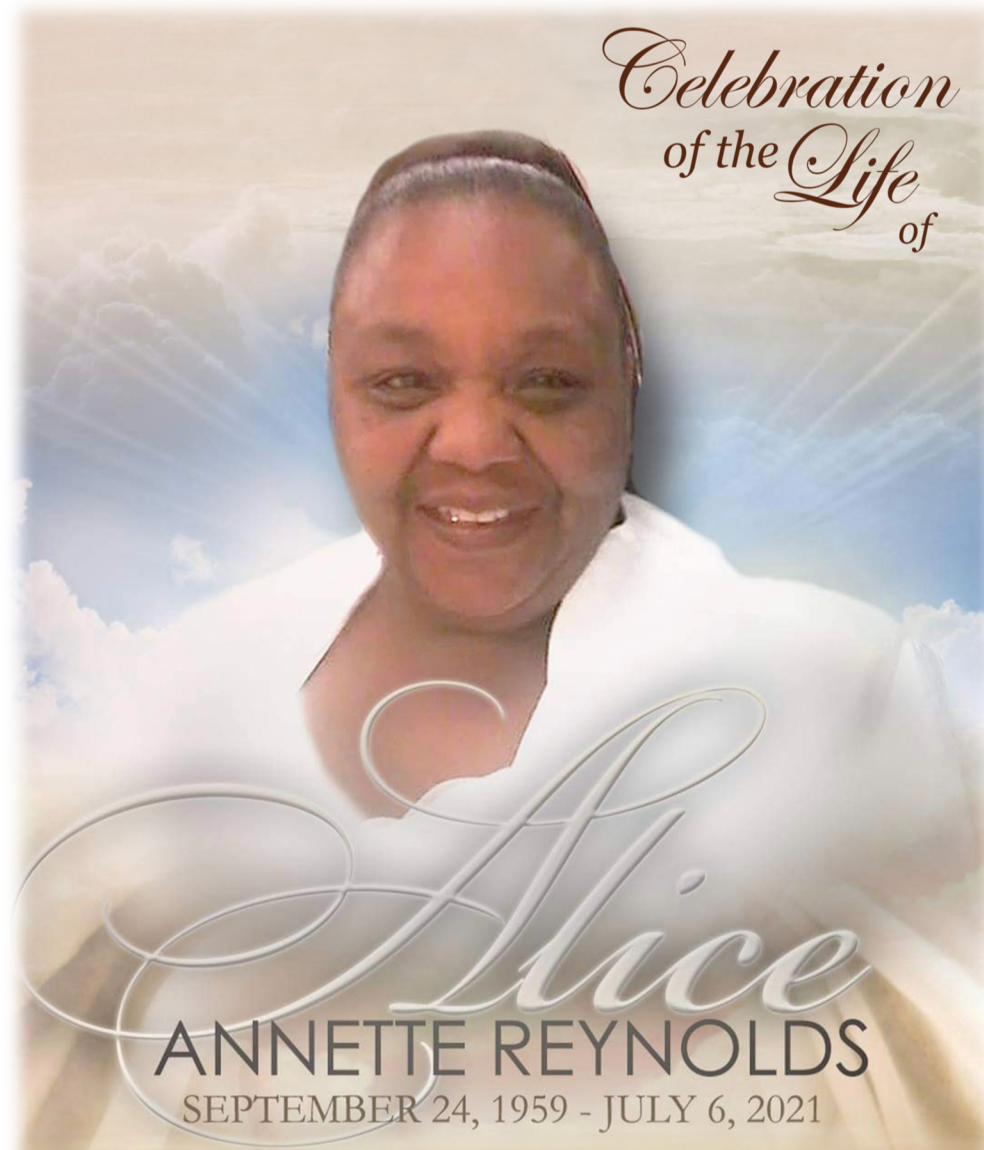
I could not stay another day
