The chain will link again*



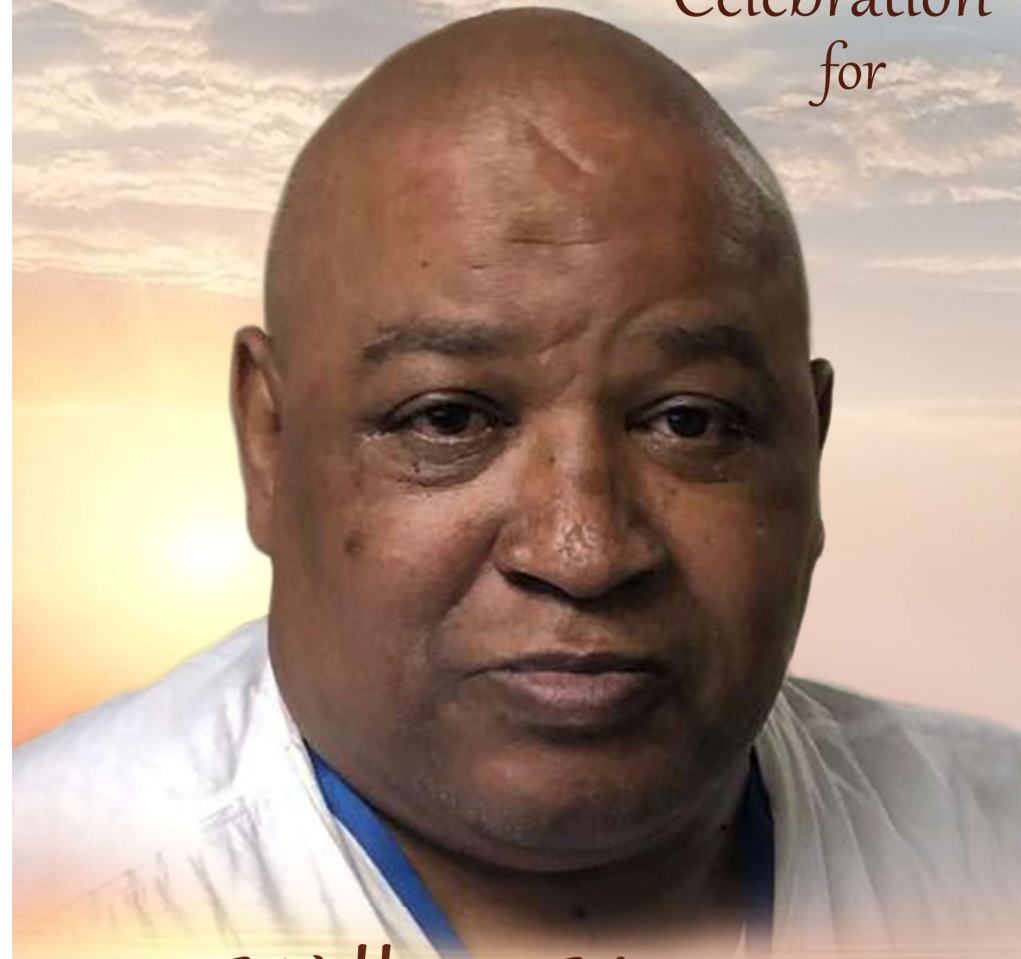
Called Away
