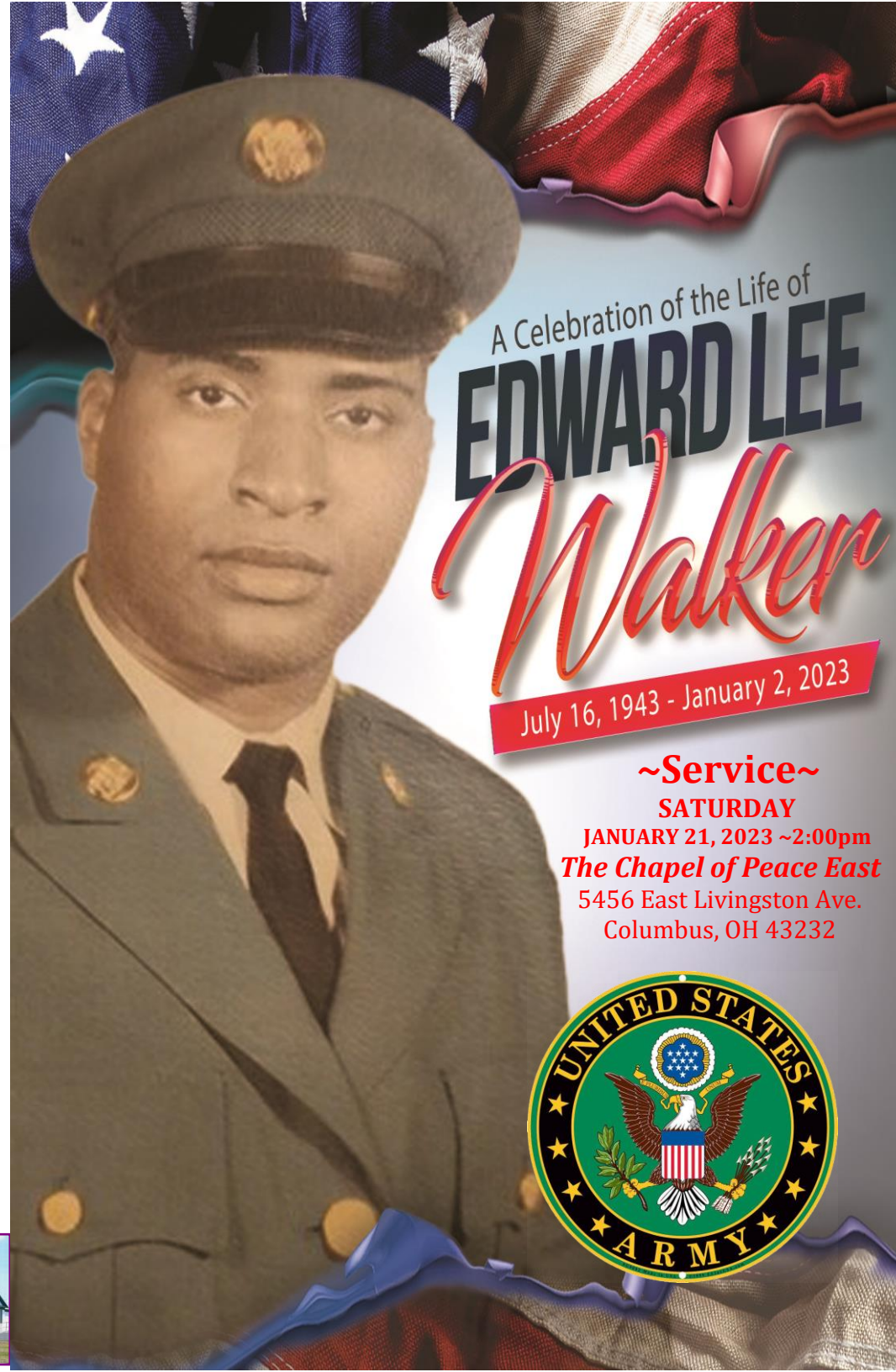


Gone Fishing
