

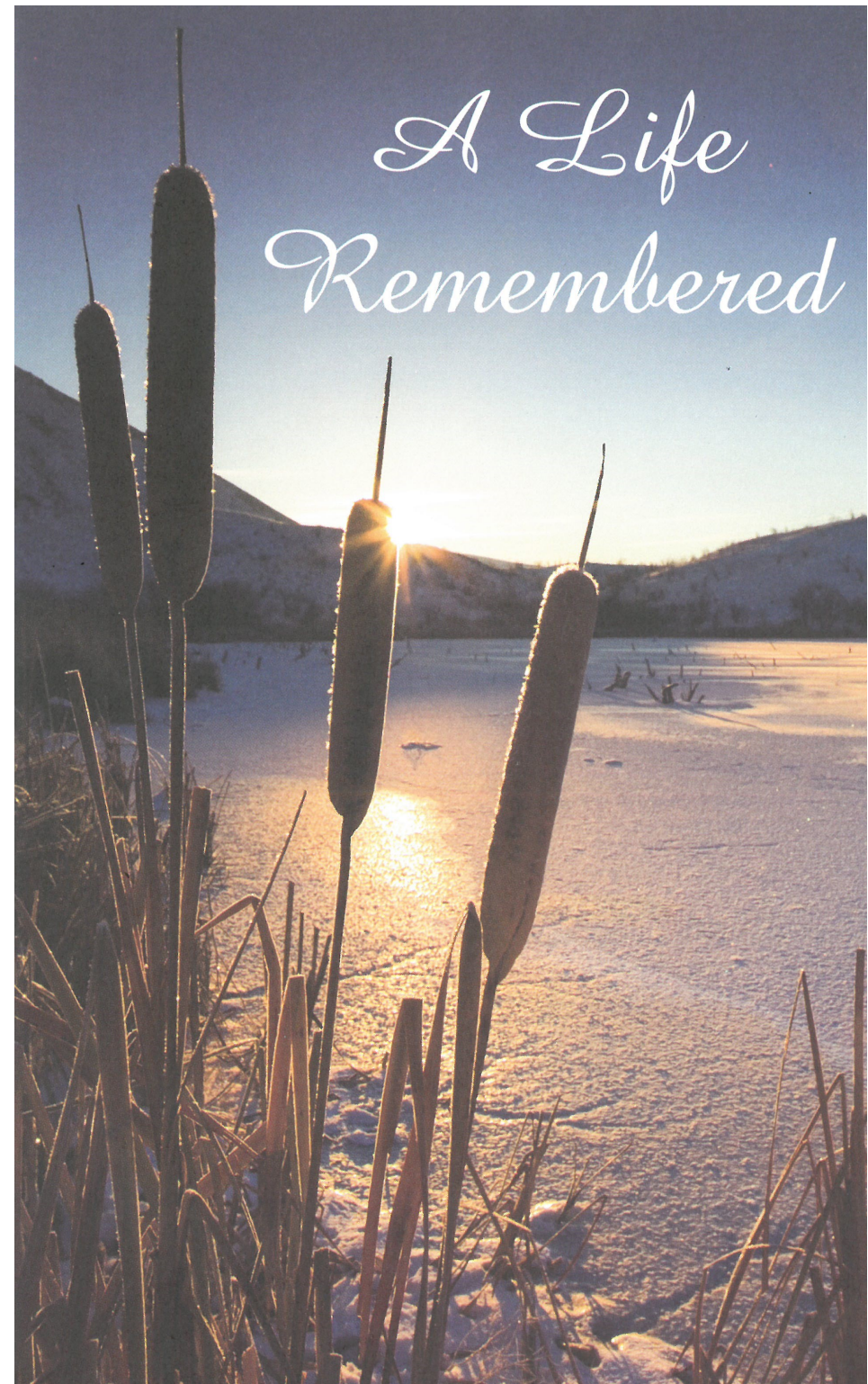
FOOTPRINTS
