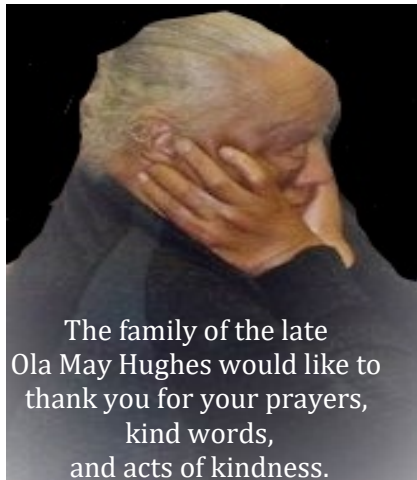


Crossing Over
