Linda was one of the matriarchs of the Broadnax -Turner family and a beautiful soul. She knew no stranger, she was a very encouraging God fearing woman, surrogate mother, servant, and Prayer Warrior to many. She attended Trinity and Bethany Baptist Church, where she was baptized and accepted the Lord as her personal savior at the age of 13 years old, under the leadership of A. Wilson Wood at Bethany.
