but never meant to stay.*

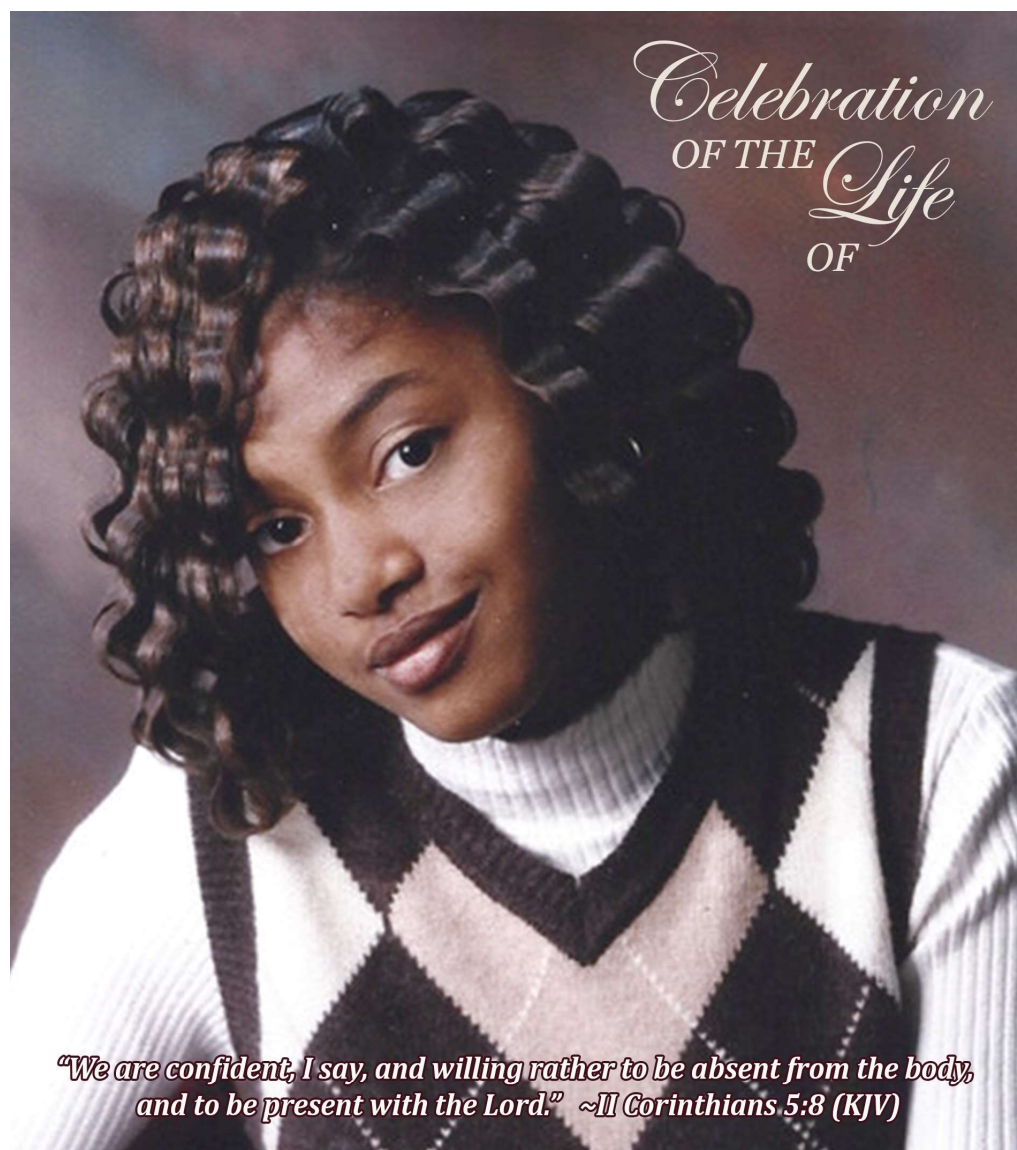
