William Floyd Miller, age 91, of Columbus, Ohio, passed away on December 9, 2023 surrounded in love by friends and family at Brookdale assisted living in Groveport, Ohio.

Bill Miller was born in Columbus, Ohio to Dora (Beltz) Tyree and Floyd A. Miller on May 24, 1932. He graduated from East High-school in 1950 with an interest in performing arts and sports. On February 19, 1951 Airman First Class (P) Miller, enlisted in the military, specializing in Aircraft and Engine Mechanics.
