Our Father claims His own.*

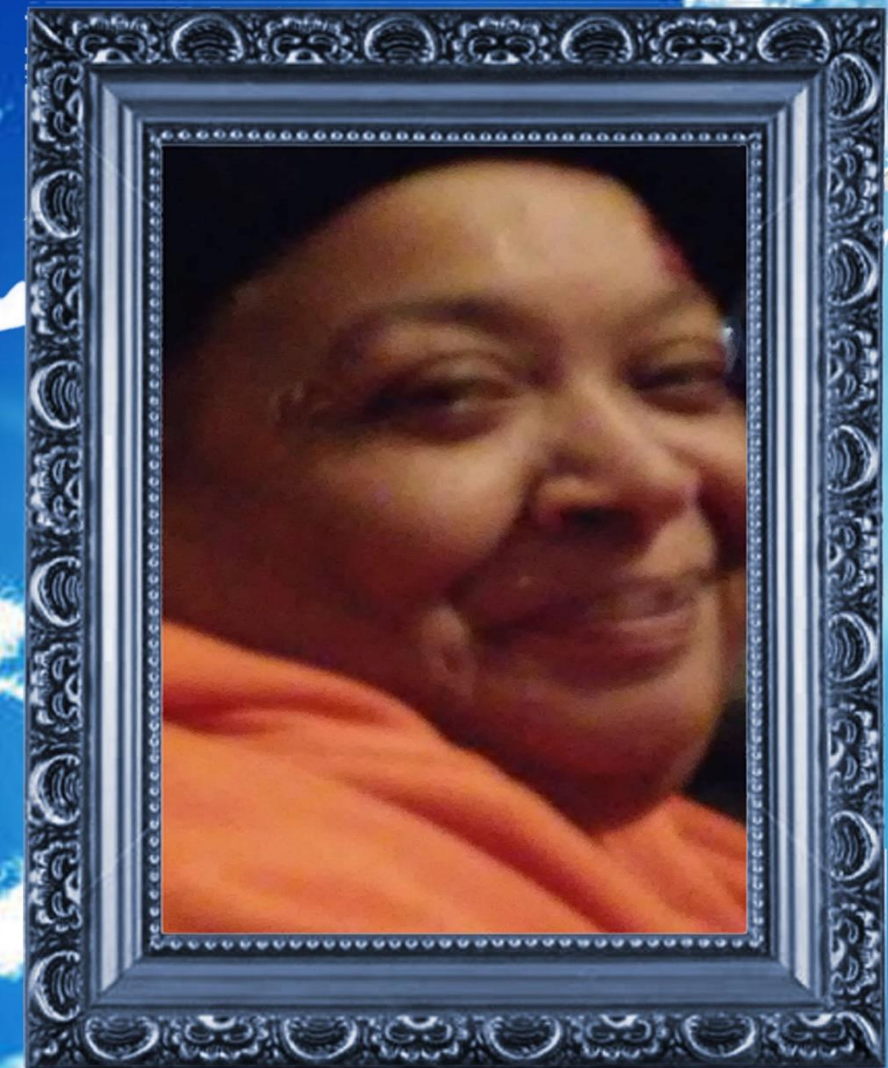
