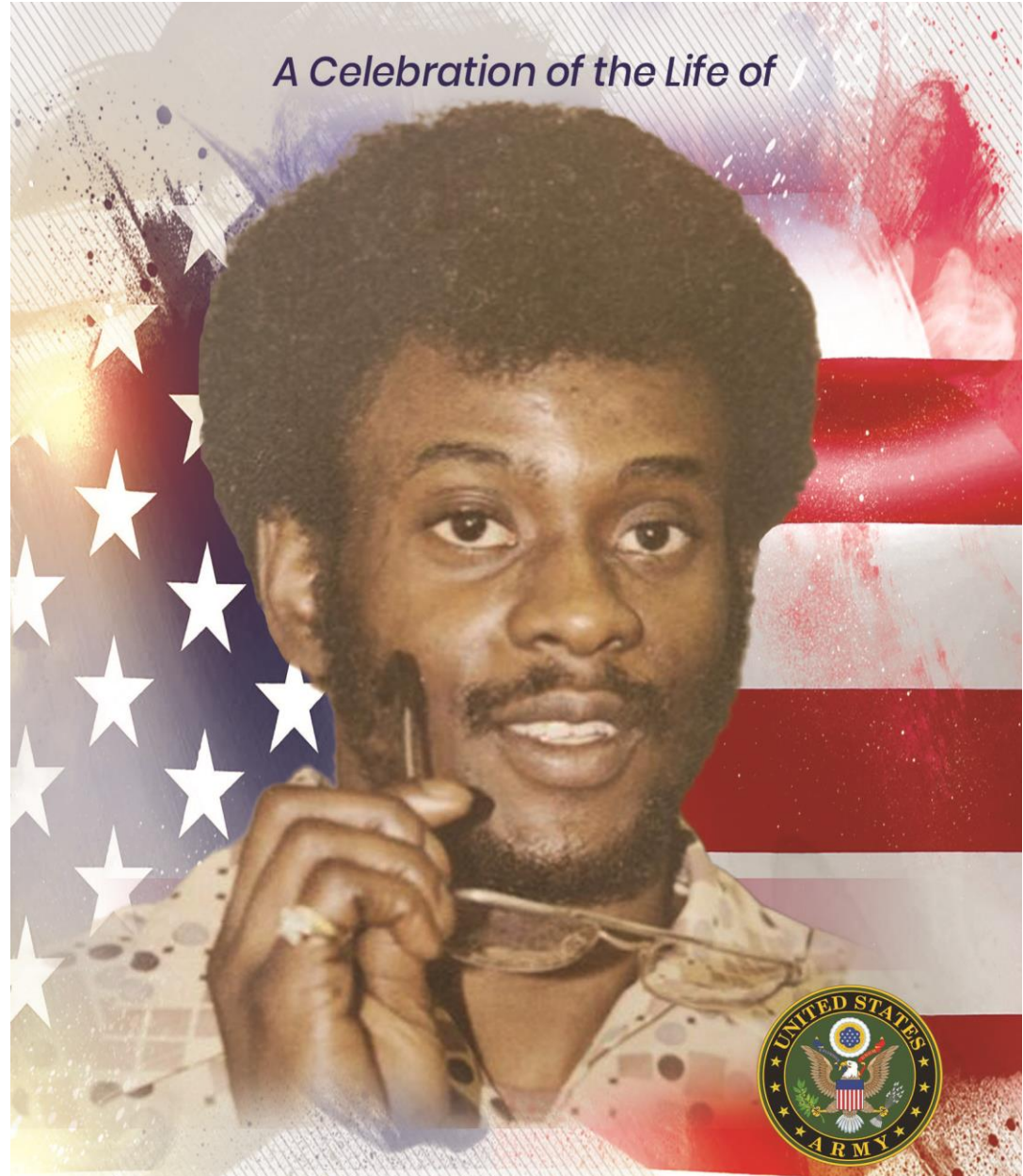
*Not, how did he die, but how did he live?
