There is not a moment that goes by we don't think of you.*

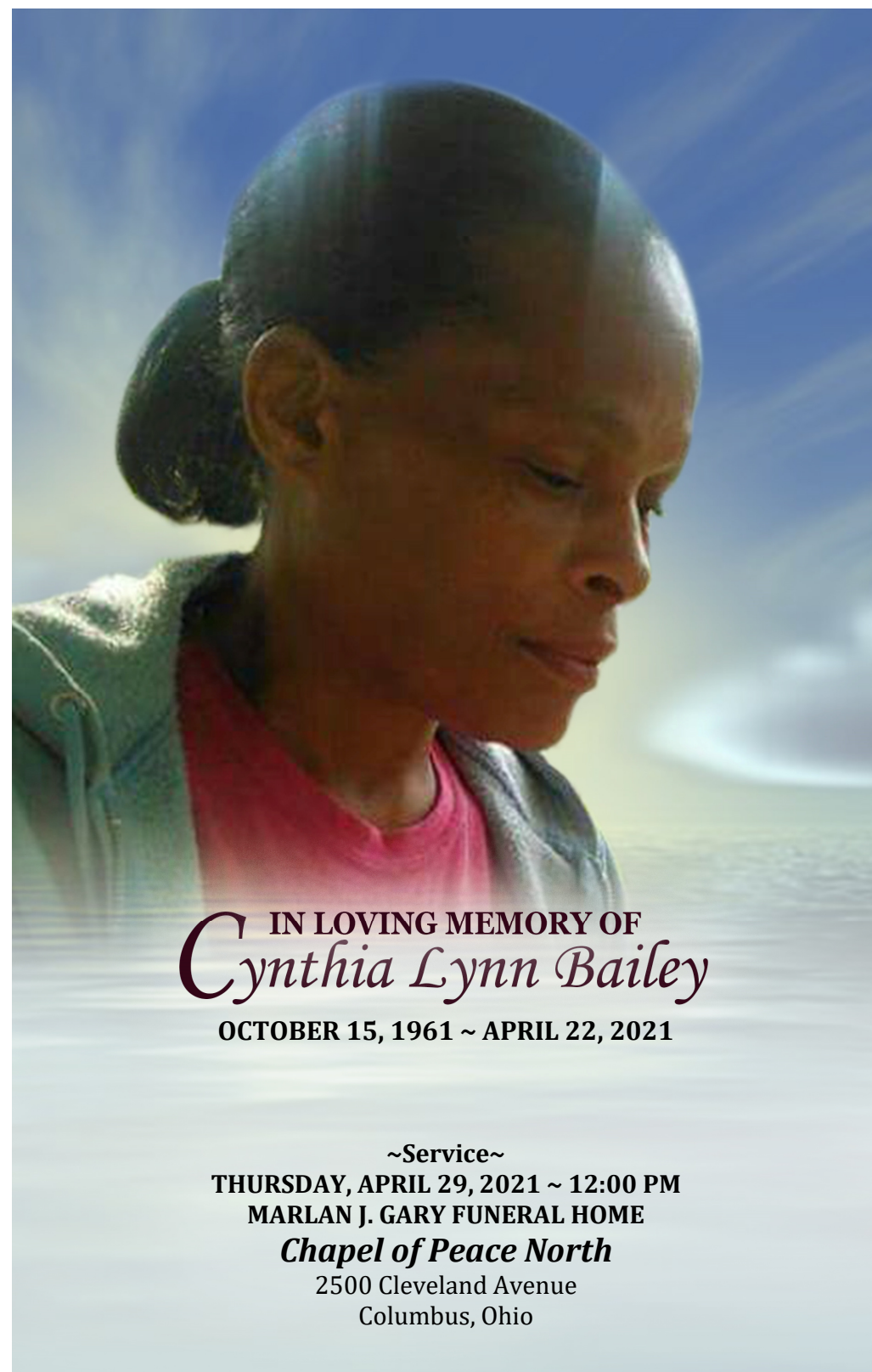
*As we lay in our beds these words ring true*
