## Reflections of Devron

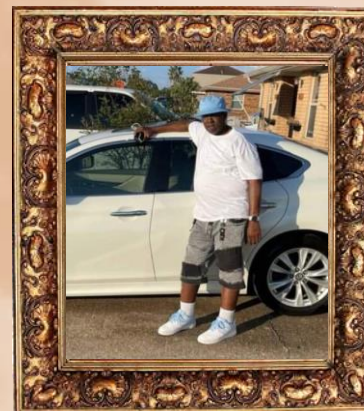
