You're always by our side

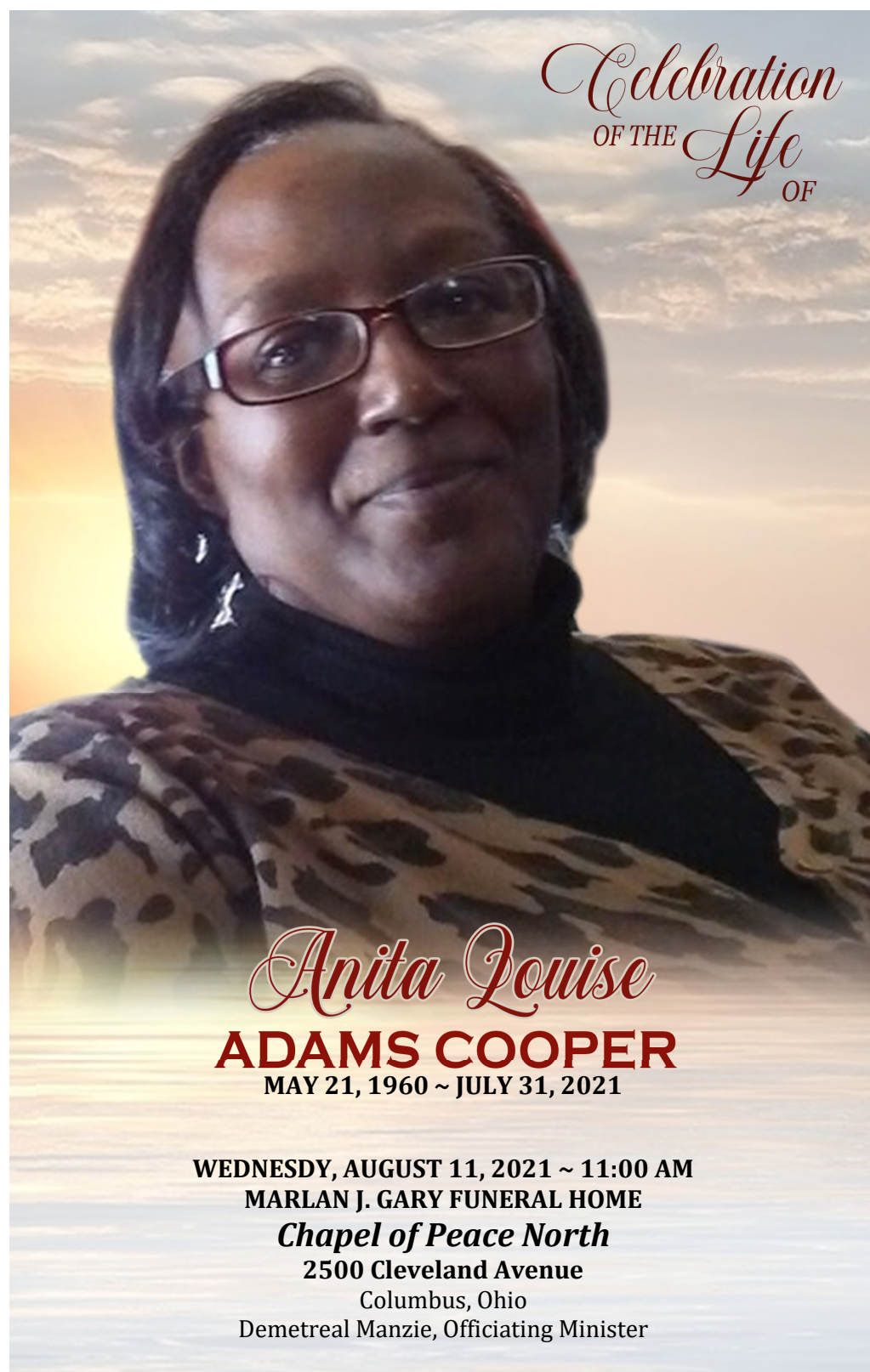
Our family chain is broken
