I'll greet you with open arms

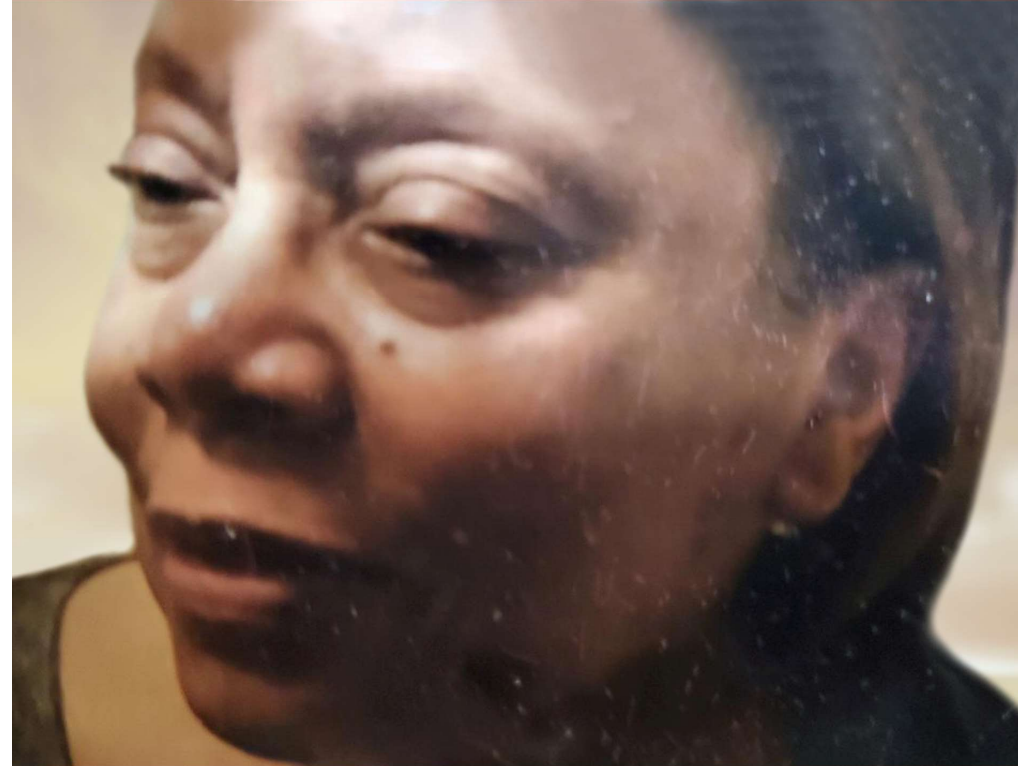
