The day God called you home*

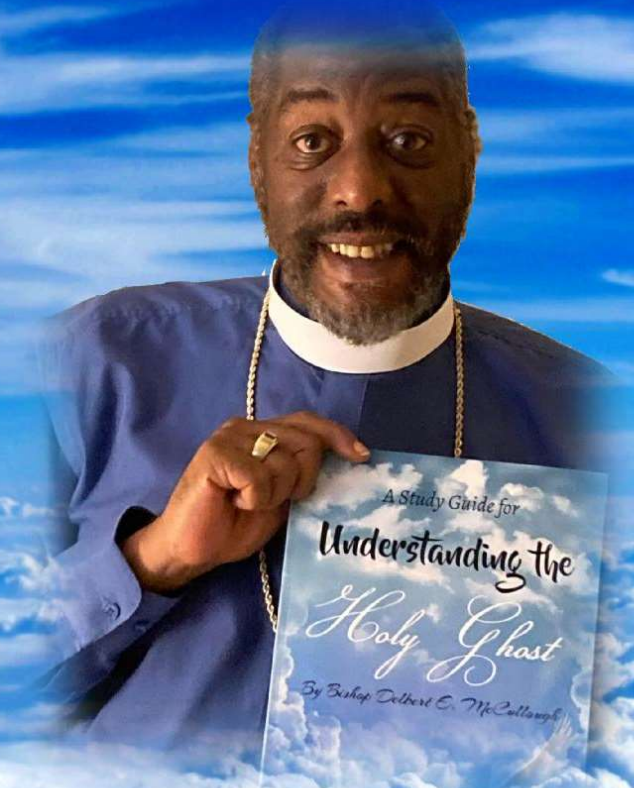
*You left us beautiful memories

The Obituary

Delbert McCullough was born on October 25, 1953

Bishop/Pastor Delbert E. McCullough Sr. 40 years of Ministry, at the age of 26, was saved at the Bibleway Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ, under Bishop William C. Latta, he received his call to the ministry in early 1982 when God spoke according to Acts 9:15 and commissioned him to bear His name, when he entered school for altar working at Bibleway Church he studied;

McCullough Sr. now serves at New Hope Global Community Church under Bishop James T. Edwards and New Hope Global Community Network of Churches Senior Bishop James T. Edwards and attends the New Hope Global Bible Institute.
