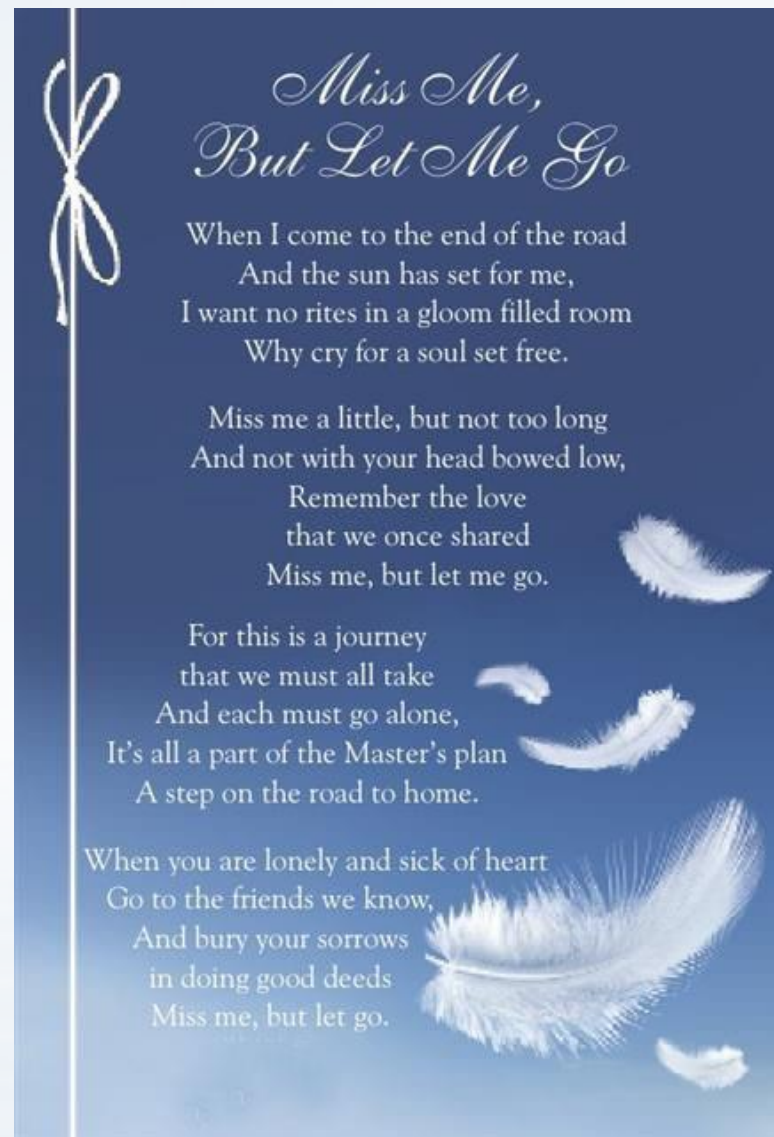


Acknowledgement
