The Broken Chain

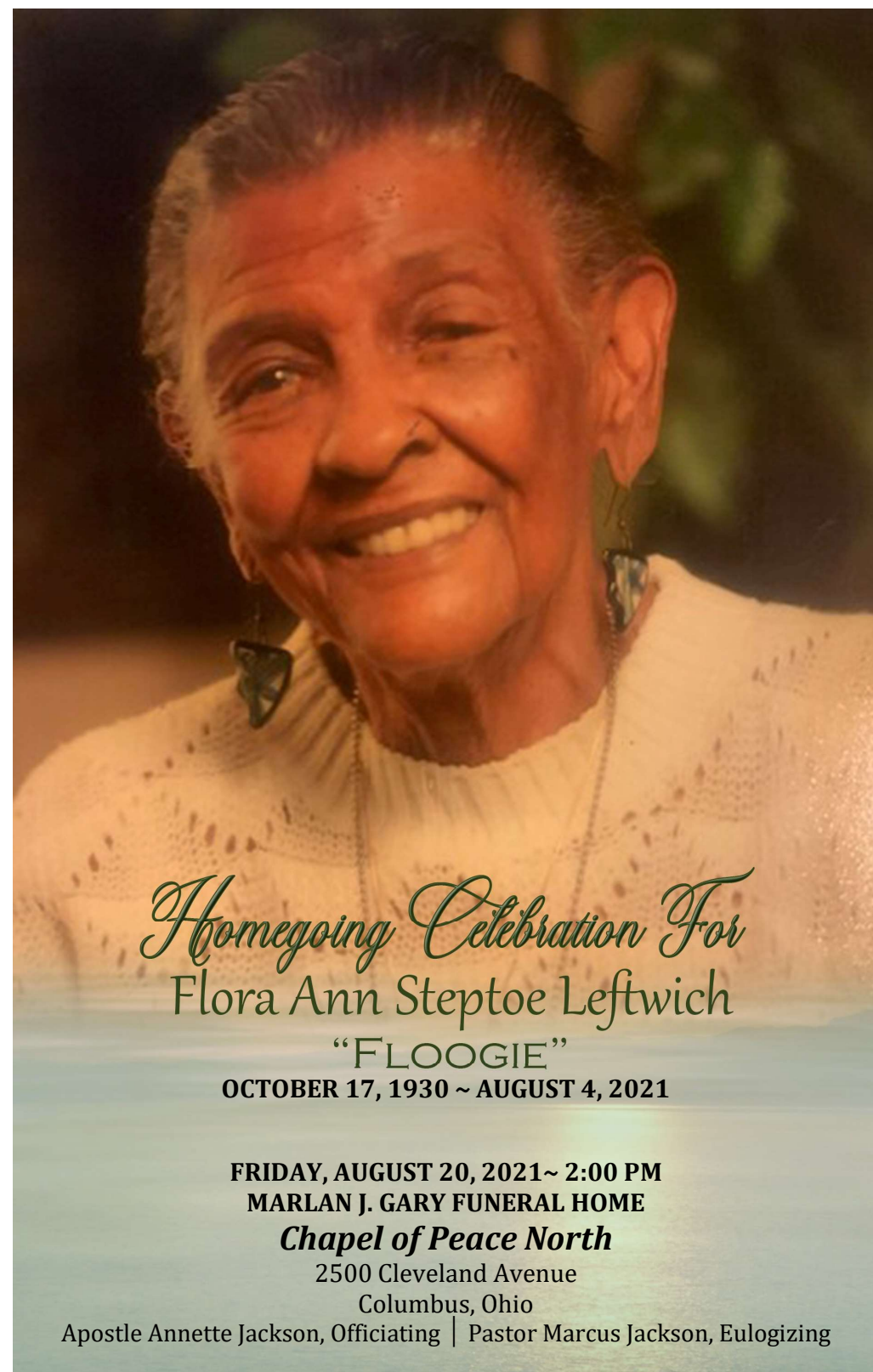
*We little knew that morning
