You taught us how to be our best To in the moment live To never hold a grudge for long And loyal friendship give


Your presence was a light and joy We never realized would someday end Just like the brilliant falling star That curved 'round heaven's bend

We will remember you forever For you, our hearts will always have room We loved you more than you will ever know You left us way too soon!




