Biography Of

MRS. LIVIA VICTORIA UMEADI HEIRSMAC (NEE OKONKWO)

She was born September 6th, 1952, to Robert and Katherine Okonkwo in Okpanam Delta state. She was the first daughter of her family. Her early education started in Okpanam primary school and she attended Lagos City College for her secondary school education. She moved to further her studies in Hamburg Germany where she trained and studied in the German language to become an Optometrist.

She became a bright, beautiful, and confident woman that stepped into unknown territories with God on her side at each step of her journey from Okpanam in Delta State to Ibadan, to Lagos and to Hamburg in Germany.

Following her graduation, she was offered several jobs back here in Nigeria, however she chose to work with UTC stores where she attended to the vision needs of several high-ranking people in the society, who came to her office to obtain or fix their glasses. She was exceptional at her craft and quickly carved a niche for herself at the UTC stores, as there were several referrals from satisfied customers.

After several years of service, she resigned and started her own eye clinic named Tapor Eye Care and she had offices in Ikeja and Ogba Lagos. She continued with her exquisite skills to create and design medical glasses and contact lens for people of diverse cultures, ages, and tribes both in Nigeria and in the diaspora specifically in the United Kingdom and the USA.

Livia loved God with all of her being and put God first in everything! She played the guitar and the piano at TREM as a member of choir. She dedicated herself to soul winning by leading evangelism battalions at the then Latter Rain Assembly (Now Citadel Global Community Church (CGCC)). She organized medical outreaches all the way to Ose local government in Ondo state, her hometown Okpanam in Delta state, Atan Otta and Sango Ota areas of Ogun state, and Agege/Ogba areas. She was passionate about soul winning and always used these events to minister the gospel.

Livia paid for buses to take new converts to church, and in her community all the children always came to her. She was also a passionate defender of the girl child and had rehabilitated a couple of teenage girls who had earlier made wrong decisions leading to early pregnancy. She would give bags of rice, fruits, clothes to the needy in the community, she had a special ministry to the old people's homes, where she provided free medical eye care especially at the home for the blind in Yaba area.

She also did some mini outreaches in the Chelmsford/Essex areas in the UK and was part of greeting and welcoming of first timers at her local church in Columbus Ohio.

Livia raised two beautiful daughters, trained, and equipped them, with wits, strength and character backing them with the strong foundation of God and the gospel. She was an embodiment of the proverbs 31 woman

She is survived by her two daughters, 2 son in-laws, 5 grandchildren and her brothers and sisters.

As we celebrate her life today, we believe that the Ernest desire of Livia Victoria Heirsmac is that all men turn their hearts to God and to submit to the love of Christ
